

MEP CHAPTER OF THE YEAR AWARD



BROTHER MEL SWANN



On January 26, 2017, The Guilford County Board of Education voted 8-1 to rename the school after Melvin C. Swann Jr., a former Guilford County Schools administrator who played an important role in the desegregation of the Greensboro school district and the merger of the Guilford, Greensboro and High Point school systems.

Starting this school year, students will attend **Swann Middle School** instead of Aycock Middle School.

Brother Melvin Swann is a Summer 1965 initiate of the Greensboro (NC) Alumni Chapter who worked for the school system for 36 years, serving as a teacher, administrator, and as the first deputy superintendent of the newly merged Guilford County Schools in 1993.
